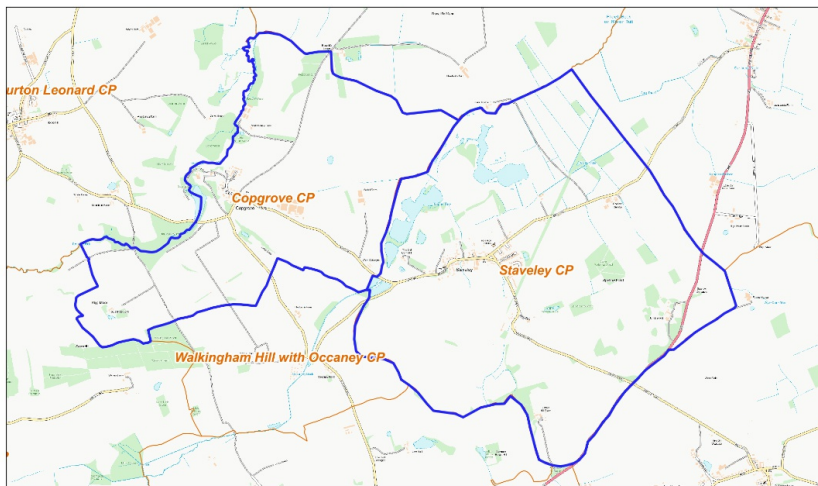

The villages of Staveley and Copgrove have decided to proceed with the development of a **Neighbourhood Plan** for the area. At its meeting in November 2018, the Staveley & Copgrove Parish Council approved the setting up of a Steering Group to undertake the plan preparation and take the plan process through its various stages. If adopted, the Neighbourhood Plan will become part of the statutory planning framework for the area and help to determine how the area evolves over the next 10 - 15 years.

The Steering Group will be meeting monthly during 2019 to formulate how the Neighbourhood Plan will be developed. These meetings are open to the public and everyone is welcome to attend and have a say. However, it's **you**, the local community, who will be the ones to decide on the plan content and to shape the final policies.

Steering Group meetings will be on the last Wednesday of the month in the Staveley & Copgrove Village Hall at 7pm. The next meeting will be 27th February 2019.

The success of the Neighbourhood Plan will be wholly dependent upon the ongoing support and involvement of the whole community. To get the plan development under way, the Steering Group would like to ask your views on any or all the following topics:

Valued attributes of the area

What are the things that you like about our area and the reasons why you enjoy living here; what do we need to conserve?

Concerns for the area

The issues that concern you most about living in the area, whether it be any aspect of transport, the environment, housing, jobs etc.,

Visions of the future

How you would like our area to be in 10 to 15 years time; how you would like any of your concerns to have been addressed.

You may use the form on the back of this leaflet to let us know your views. Continue on separate sheets of paper if necessary. Complete one for each household member if possible. All responses are anonymous.

A member of the Steering Group will call to collect any completed forms on or a few days before 25th February 2019.

You can also let us know your views by completing the form online via the Parish Council website at <https://staveleyandcopgrovepc.org.uk> and following the **Neighbourhood Plan - Initial Community Consultation** menu option.

Another part of this initial consultation will be a series of workshops, to be held in the **Staveley & Copgrove Village Hall** in **March** and **April** 2019, which will offer an opportunity for you to discuss your views on these topics with the Steering Group and other community members. Check the website for workshop details.

Following this initial consultation exercise, the Steering Group will collate the responses and prepare a household survey that will establish the degree of support within the community for each of the valued attributes, concerns and visions for the future put forward. This will then provide a basis for the development of plan policies.
