1. To Receive Apologies

2. To Receive Declarations of Interest

3. To Confirm Minutes of the Meeting of 7 January 2013

The minutes of the meeting were accepted as a record.

4. Open Session

4.1 Nature Reserve - A resident present stated that the walked path across Manor Farm was not the official line. NYCC have proposed that the walked line could be accepted as the official line subject to the agreement of the landowner. NYCC would also fence the path at a width of 2 metres.

Confirmed that the PC had received a copy letter from the Parochial Church Council to YWT complaining about visitors leaving the nature reserve via the church yard.

4.2 Village Green – Concerns were made regarding positioning of newly planted bulbs leaving areas of the green potentially uncut after the flowering period and in being planted in areas likely to be trampled by children using the green.

4.3 Highway repairs – Suggested that NYCC will repair potholes if exact locations are confirmed to NYCC in writing.

4.4 Best wishes were expressed to Mr G Clarke for a full and speedy recovery.

5.1 Nature Reserve – Further meeting to be arranged for after Easter

5.2 Vehicle Activated Signs – It was confirmed that Staveley was not included in the first batch of villages to be considered.

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5.4–Minskip Road Parking – It was confirmed that letters regarding parking had been prepared by NYCC Police and circulated by the school to all parents.
