### **1. To Receive Apologies**

### **3. To Confirm Minutes of the Meeting of 16<sup>th</sup> November 2016**

### **4. Update from Nick Duxbury at Local level**

In the last week Nick has heard of a major sugar beet producer wanting to create a plant next to the incinerator of the A168. Reiterated the potential boundary changes however the final decision is still awaited. If we do become part of Selby & Ainsty Nick indicated this could impact on the housing development plans.

### **5. Crime update from PC Powell**

1 incident in last month, attempted theft of vehicle in Copgrove. PC Powell recommended us logging on the N Yorks Police Portal the concerns over speeding through the village. BK asked if Staveley could have a police presence in the village during school start and end times.

Regarding Poaching and Hare coursing, any incidents should be reported as soon as possible with as many details as the Police will process offenders through the courts.

## **6. Recreational Field**

Park Lane are yet to start the repainting as waiting for good weather. KA has purchased some child friendly solution to remove the moss from the surfaces around the equipment.

## **7. Burning back of Abacus**

There has been no further burning at this site since it was reported. HBC are still investigating the construction work at Abacus started without any planning application.

## **8. SNR/YWT**

Concerns over the height of West Lake after the assurances that it would be kept low during winter to relieve pressure on potential flooding. Footpath is flooded again. RT to meet with Swale and Ure drainage board and questioned if the Parish Council should have a declaration of intent from YWT. DC to arrange meeting with YWT to understand their responsibility to their neighbours.

## **9. Invoices and Credits**

Clerk advised that current bank balance is £9,725.51.

The grant for grass cutting by the council is to be reduced over the next 3yrs, by 2020 no grant will be paid. A loss of approx. £500 to the parish council

Question was raised by member of public about any applications for land behind the pinfold. Clerk confirmed after speaking with HBC Planning there have been no applications.

Concerns from members of public over buses not stopping to collect passenger/running late or not even turning up. Sign does not indicate waiting on both sides of the road either. Clerk to investigate and report back.

HBC have requested details of the parishes Emergency Planning information. Parish Council to discuss and confirm details back to clerk to pass on to HBC.
