Subject: Highways works in Staveley

Dear Deborah,

Further to our recent correspondence, Staveley & Copgrove Parish Council met last week to discuss the current situation regarding highway defects in the area. The action proposed by NYCC was welcomed, and the PC looks forward to its implementation.

As a result of these discussions the PC would also like to draw NYCC's attention to these other issues:-

1. Large puddle formation at junction of Park View and Main Street. This is caused by inadequate camber in the road to allow water to drain away after rain, and the result is that pedestrians get soaked by passing traffic.
2. Large puddle formation outside Ceres House (previously reported by local resident Sarah Whitworth). Similarly caused by inadequate camber and drainage facilities in the road.
3. Many of the gullies in the village are full and urgently need emptying
4. Re-fixing of direction sign on village green (previously reported – your incident number 1034774)
5. In order to help maintenance of the 20 mph limit on Minskip Road, it would be helpful if signs were painted on the road itself, especially in the vicinity of Staveley school
6. The road markings on both Spellow Grove and Spellow Crescent have almost disappeared, and it would be desirable to have these re-painted at the same time as the other road marking work required in the village.

I look forward to hearing from you as regards these points.

Meanwhile I also look forward to meeting you at the Parish Portal consultation meeting on Tuesday 4th February at your offices.
