**Notice of Confirmation of a Public Path Extinguishment and
Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order
Highways Act 1980 Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981
The North Yorkshire Council
Public Footpath No. 15.124/9, Low Field Lane and Pinfold Green, Staveley,
Extinguishment Order 2026**

On 8th May 2026, The North Yorkshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish the public footpath described below and modify The Former West Riding of Yorkshire (Area 2) Definitive Map and Statement accordingly. Public Footpath No. 15.124/9 between SE3677 6272 and SE3691 6265 will be extinguished. A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Knaresborough Library, North Yorkshire until 16th July 2026. Copies of the Order and Map may be purchased from Definitive Map Team, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 01609 532512) at a cost of £2.00, or can be downloaded free from our website www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices. The Order comes into force on 8th May 2026, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 16th July 2026 make an application to the High Court.
